Important Notice

The congress venue is located one hour by car from Vienna. The best public transportation is a Fast Bus from Vienna. To reach this bus from Vienna Airport, you should take the railway S7 (direction Wien-Floridsdorf) until Wien-Praterstern Station (29 mins, € 3,60). The S7 leaves every 30 minutes (at :18 and :48, i.e 12:48, 13:18, 13:48).

In front of Wien-Praterstern Station, at Lasalle-Street, the Fast Bus No. 1028 leaves at 14:25 (direction Litschau) and arrives at 15:38 in Horn-Main Square, where we will welcome you.

So please make sure that your flight arrives in Vienna before 12:30 to reach that bus.

If you arrive in Vienna earlier, for visiting etc., you're welcome to leave your luggage in our office in the center of town. From there the bus stop at Wien-Praterstern is easily accessible by metro U1 (10 mins.).

After the congress the participants will be brought back to Vienna and to the airport by an organized bus, which will leave at Horn at 13:30, stop at Vienna centre at 14:30 and arrive at the airport not later than 15:00. Your flight departure time therefore should be after 16:30.
